


The Second Ice Age – Was Partial









At the time of the flood in the days of Noah some of the waters that had come from the outer space since the extinction of the dinosaurs, found a barrier on our outer atmosphere and formed a "mono-layer" outside and around it, some call it "the canopy"; then, when the windows of heaven (arubbot, **floodgates**, chimneys, the **ozone holes**) were **opened** (pathach), the waters entered like a thick and huge waterfall through both of the poles, forming immediately the permafrost.







Make thee an ark of **gopher wood** [already petrified wood!]; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.





"Ark" (*tebah*) is an obscure term that is only used again for the basket that carried baby Moses (Exod. 2:3). They were physically very different, but they had a similar function, so it could mean something like "lifeboat." The Bible does not specify the shape of the ark but only its length, breadth, and height — the most basic information for any ship. To a ship designer, these dimensions are immediately recognizable — just like a modern cargo ship. 150 x 50 x 30 Cubits [Egyptian, 20.62 in a cubit]



"Rooms" (*qen*) means "nests" in the rest of the Bible and there is no reason to avoid it here. As nests, it would be inappropriate to imagine animals lined up on display or herded together in huge stalls. Neither option would suit animal transport, anyway. Instead, we should be thinking of snug, private enclosures where an animal would like to hide and bed down. **Noah's Ark: Thinking Outside the Box**









"Pitch" (*kopher*) means "ransom," but is uniquely called pitch here, probably from the root word *kapher* (to cover). Noah also applied pitch to the inside of the ark — perhaps as a preservative during the long construction process or to make the interior more resistant to fungal attack. Pitch was traditionally made from tree gum, producing an amber-colored resin that was glossy yet tacky. Alternatively, Noah may have used bitumen if God arranged pre-Flood oil deposits, but this would give a black interior.


the Armenians call this place * A $\pi o \rho \alpha \tau \eta \epsilon i \sigma v$, the Place of Descent; for the ark being saved in that place, its remains are showed there by the inhabitants to this day.

1 * This amogarmuor, or place of descent, is the proper rendering of the Armenian name of this very city. It is called in Ptolmey, Naruana, and by Moses Chorenensis, the Armenian historian, Idsheuan; but at the place itself, Nachidsheuan, which signifies the first place of descent; and is a lasting monument of the preservation of Noah in the ark, upon the top of that mountain, at whose foot it was built, as the first city or town after the flood. See Antiq. B. xx. chap. ii. sect. 3. vol. ii. and Moses Chorenensis, p. 71, 72; who also says, p. 19, that another town was related by tradition to have been called Seron, or the place of dispersion, on account of the dispersion of Xisuthrus, or Noah's sons, from thence first made. Whether any remains of this ark be still preserved, as the people of the country suppose, I cannot certainly tell. Mons. Turnfort had not very long since a mind to see the place himself, but met with too great dangers and difficulties to venture through them.







§ 6. Now all the writers of barbarian histories make mention of this flood, and of this ark, and among them Berosus the Chaldæan. For describing the circumstances of the flood, he goes on thus:—" It is said, there is still some part of the vessel in Armenia, near the mountain of the Cordyæans,¹ and that some people carry off pieces of its bitumen, which they use as charms." Hieronymus the Egyptian also, who wrote the Phœnician Antiquities, and Mnaseas, and many more, make mention of the same. Nicolaus of Damascus, in his ninety-sixth book, gives the

¹ The Cordyæan Mountains separated Armenia from Assyria, and the name is preserved in *Kurds* and *Kurdistân*. Berosus probably alludes to the "Mountain of Nizir," or *Rowandiz*, on which the ark of the Chaldæan Noah rested. Josephus. G. Bell and Sons, 1900.

² Josephus identifies the mountain upon which the ark rested with the traditional Mount Ararat. For discussion on the more probable site to the south, see Smith's "Dictionary of the Bible," 'Ararat.'













DIAGRAM LOOKING SOUTH INTO THE MOUNTAINS OF URARTU


















Analysis and Comparison of the Two Ark Impressions at Mt. Mashu / Ziyaret, Turkey
