



The center of the worship of Yahweh by the people of Israel from shortly after the Exodus until it was replaced by Solomon's temple around 960 B.C.




Possible site of the crucifixion of Jesus











...Goliath, of Gath, whose height was <u>six</u> cubits and a span (> 9 ft, 3 mt). And he had

1) an helmet of brass upon his head, and he was

2) armed with a coat of mail; and the weight of the coat *was* five thousand shekels (125 Lb, 57 Kg) of brass.

3) And *he had* greaves of brass upon his legs,
4) and a target of brass between his shoulders.
5) And the staff of his spear *was* like a weaver's beam;

<u>6</u>) and his spear's head *weighed* <u>six</u> hundred shekels (15 Lb, 7 Kg) of iron.... was called "The Pavement" in John 19:13. The Greek means "Pavement-Stone" or "paved with flagstones" as was the high rock which Josephus tells us that Fort Antonia was built around.

The Wailing Wall

was crucified "outside the camp" (Hebrews 13:12-13). This symbolic evidence and much early written evidence supports the belief that Jesus was crucified and buried east of the Temple on the Mount of Olives.

The Pinnacle of the Temple at its SE corner was 450 feet (40 stories) high according to Josephus and was where Satan tempted Jesus to jump from (Matthew 4:5-7).

The Gihon Spring was where David put the tabernacle and where Solomon was anointed king (1 Kings 1:38-39). The Gihon Spring was underneath the Temple and represented the river or fountain of life flowing from and underneath the throne of God (Revelation 22:1, Joel 3:18, Zechariah 14:8).

Approximate location of the Temple (white square)




Almost every important political or religious figure goes there to pray thinking that it's part of the ancient Jewish Temple!








The next photo shows the view down to the bottom of the Kidron Valley from where the Temple stood according to Ernest Martin.







